

Young People's Chair for districts

Sobriety *Suggestion*: 2 years of continuous sobriety

1. This is a *suggested* 2-year commitment which rotates with the Area 72 committee.
2. Attend monthly district meetings.
3. Have a working knowledge of and willingness to adhere to the 12 Steps, 12 Traditions, and 12 Concepts of Alcoholics Anonymous
4. Have knowledge of the meetings in the district.
5. The district young people's chair will find outreach opportunities for young people's events and service activities
6. Reach out to university and schools to find out if there is a need to start on-campus meetings.
7. Coordinate workshops aimed at young people on traditions and concepts.
8. Encourage meetings that attract young people to designate themselves as a young persons meeting as means for accessibility purpose.
9. Determine if there is a need in the district to create a young person's meeting, unless in direct conflict with neighboring meetings.
10. Help existing service bodies such as PI/CPC, H&T, Corrections and Bridge the Gap with finding young speakers for panels, workshops and 12 step calls for any young alcoholic in need
